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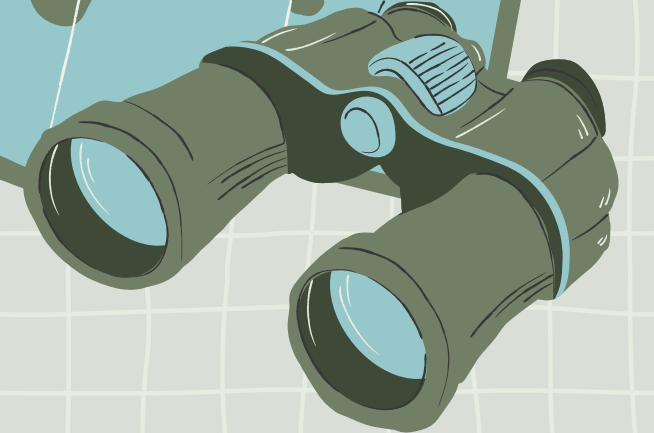
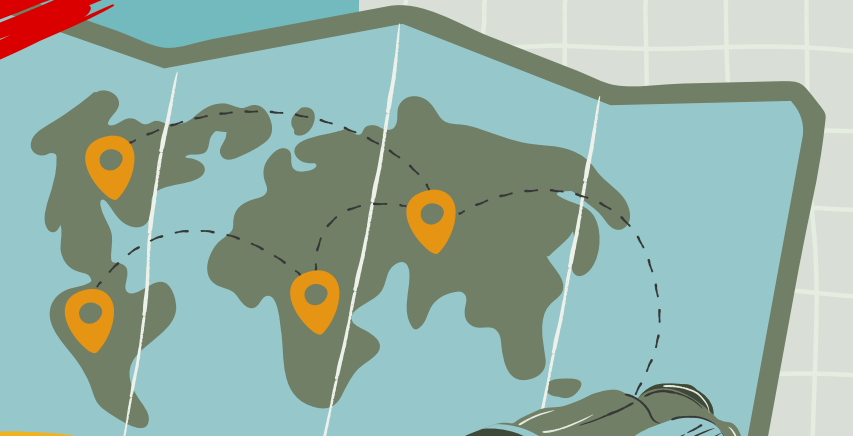

# The education and training system in Turkey consists of some stages

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In the Republic of  
Turkey, 12 years of  
education is compulsory  
for every male and  
female citizen



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In this education system, every student who completes his/her education is given a "Secondary Education Diploma".

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# Pre-School Education



It is the education given as a preparation for school to prepare the child for primary education. There is no obligation, but pre-school education is encouraged by the state and related institutions

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# Primary School Education



Students, who are 66 months old and over, study in primary school.

The starting age for education is 5 and a half.

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# Primary School Education

Children who are eligible to start school can automatically start their education from the first grade of the primary school closest to their address.



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# Primary School Education

During the first 4 years, that is, in primary schools (primary education first stage), students are given education with a lighter curriculum. First of all, they are included in a three-month school preparation program.

These students start to read English from the second year, and the Religious Culture and Moral Knowledge course from the fourth year.



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# SECONDARY SCHOOL EDUCATION

Transition to secondary school is made via the e-registration system, just like the transition to primary school.



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# SECONDARY SCHOOL EDUCATION

Secondary schools give students the opportunity to have the right to change their decisions freely and freely in their education processes as a freer individual, in accordance with the understanding of civil society and democratic state.



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# SECONDARY SCHOOL EDUCATION

The purpose of secondary schools is to provide training in vocational or student skills.

For this reason, elective courses are provided to be taught



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# SECONDARY SCHOOL EDUCATION

In secondary school, there are courses such as Maths,  
Turkish, English, Science,  
Art, Sports and Social Studies.



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# HIGH SCHOOL EDUCATION

Placement in high schools, starting from the 2017-2018 academic year, started to be implemented as the High School Transition System (LGS).

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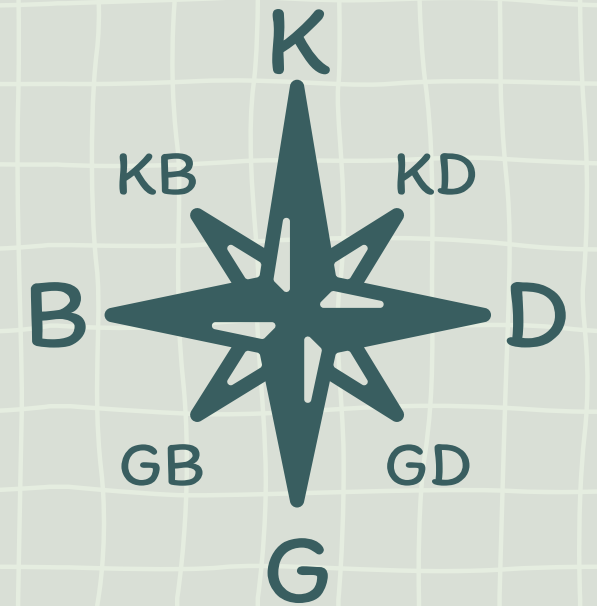
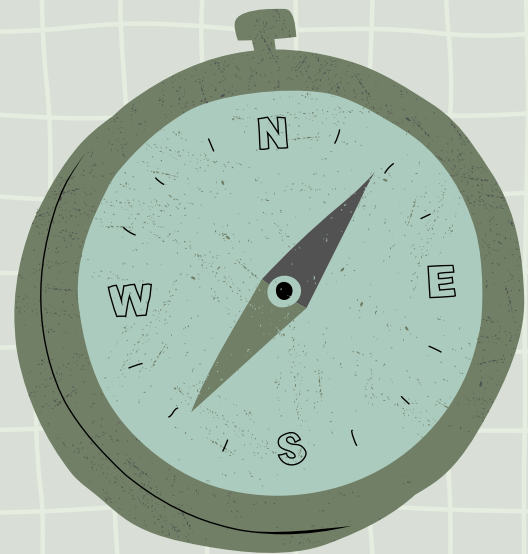
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# UNIVERSITY EDUCATION IN TURKEY

There are usually two types of universities: Faculties and Vocational Schools. Faculties are usually for four years. Vocational Schools are generally aimed at trade-vocational high school graduates and generally provide two-year education



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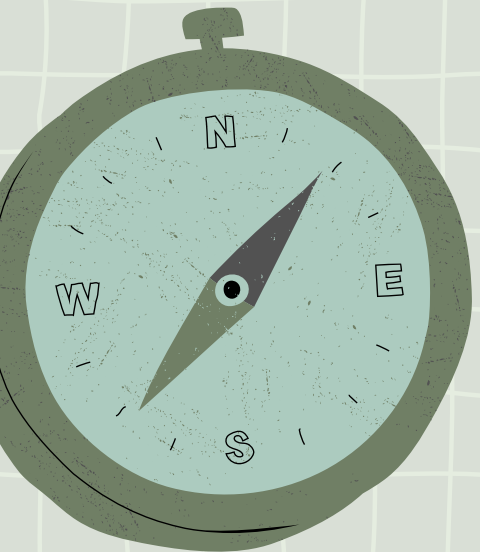




# UNIVERSITY EDUCATION IN TURKEY



There is no expulsion from university in Turkey. In addition, a university student can transfer as he/she wishes (depending on his/her grades). In addition, after the first year in the common class at the faculty he/she chooses, he/she starts to study by choosing his/her own department in the second year (like high school education). However, this does not apply to every university



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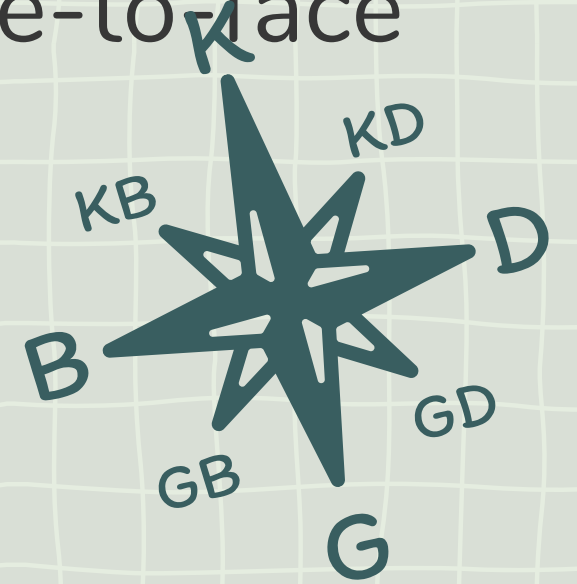
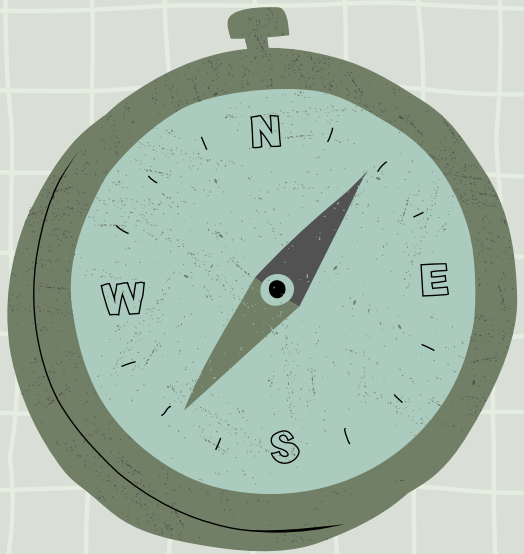
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# UNIVERSITY EDUCATION IN TURKEY

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# SCIENCE AND ART CENTERS



Science and Art Centers or "BİLSEM" in short in Turkish; These are the schools that provide education with special curricula to support the potential of gifted children. BİLSEM schools, which serve under the Ministry of National Education, are not an alternative to formal education.



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# SCIENCE AND ART CENTERS



Students who enter the Science and Art Center are taken to a 5-stage education program. All programs are prepared by the teachers in a student-centered manner that will develop students' creativity, different approaches to problems and their ability to find solutions, and prepare them for the conditions in adulthood.



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# SCIENCE AND ART CENTERS



While students act for the purpose of getting passing grades and preparing for exams in their schools, BİLSEM's structure includes passing grades, taking notes, etc.

Since the objectives are not included, instead, education is provided with a process-oriented, project-based learning model and students are expected to realize products/projects that meet the desired qualifications.

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# SCIENCE AND ART CENTERS



Student admission to Science and Art Centers is done by examination and intelligence test. Primary school 1st, 2nd and 3rd grade students can take this exam. The winning student gains the right to study until the last year of high school. Lessons take place after the student's formal education or on the weekend.
